**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW,  
OKLAHOMA IN SUPPORT OF AND CALLING FOR CITIZENS TO VOTE IN THE BOND  
ELECTION ON FEBRUARY 10, 2015 FOR BROKEN ARROW PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

**WHEREAS**, Broken Arrow Public Schools District serves the Broken Arrow community by providing quality education for Broken Arrow students through academic programs, superior facilities and quality faculty; and,

**WHEREAS**, Broken Arrow Public Schools has called a bond election to take place on February 10, 2015; and,

**WHEREAS**, this bond election seeks voter approval for the issuance of \$370,000,000.00 for improvement projects. The proposed projects include:
