Per Pupil Funding

Per Pupil Funding is the average amount of money that the government spends per student. This number is calculated based on the district's student count and is a primary source of revenue for general funds.



Does Not Include



These moneys are derived from non-dedicated state sources such as property taxes, local contributions and federal dollars. These funds **CANNOT** be used to pay teacher salaries. By adding these funds into the calculation, it will disproportionately show state contribution.
